

Guidelines for applying to the Inaugural International Limestone Coast Video Art Festival.

To be considered for the Inaugural International Limestone Coast Video Art Festival:

Entry Period: Friday 2 March 2018 – Friday, 30 March, 2018.

Eligibility:

- The Video Artworks must be completed or released between January 2014 and February 2018. They can be single-channel videos, video installations, or Internet-based Video-Art.
- The entrant must hold the copyright of the submitted work. If the work is submitted by a representative, permission from the copyright holder must be obtained. You certify that you have full authorisation to enter the submitted artwork into this festival, and you certify that you have full authorisation to the use of the images and sounds in the submitted work.
- All works must be under 12 minutes.
- You hold the Inaugural International Limestone Coast Video Art Festival harmless from any damages to the submitted material, and harmless from all claims of liability resulting from your entry.
- You permit the Inaugural International Limestone Coast Video Art Festival the rights to use stills, and press materials from your video art for promotional purposes.
- Submitting your work to the Inaugural International Limestone Coast Video Art Festival entails that you have read, understand, and agree to the submission guidelines listed above.

Please include the following in your application:

- A current CV/Biography, please include where you currently reside (country and state)
- Vimeo link/s to your work, a maximum of three (3) works, no more than 12 minutes each, can be submitted. These should be finished works, intended for the Festival.
- Details of the work/s: title, name of author(s), synopsis of work, date of production
- Please include how this work should be displayed i.e. what technology it needs to run, what format it's displayed in, etc.
- How your work relates to the theme 'The Lived Body'
